APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Application Deadline: Monday, November 27, 2023 | 5:00 PM

Applicants can apply as a teaching artist or school participant. A school educator is defined as arts specialists (classroom music teachers, visual arts teachers, drama teachers, etc.), classroom educators, inclusion and special education teachers, and school/department administrators. Applicants who have an existing relationship with a teaching artist/school are encouraged to apply as a two-person team. Applicants should have at least 1 - 5 years of experience in the field of education or arts education. Priority will be given to new applicants.

The participants are expected to:

- Attend PD workshops during the school day and on weekends.
- Participate in follow-up workshops and collaborate with a teammate in presenting lesson plans based on the assigned workshop.
- Pilot new teaching strategies in their classroom or teaching practice through 3-day mini residencies.
- Have administrator approval and a commitment to participate in a 3-day residency with a teaching artist. The administrator will be expected to participate in the residency planning meeting.
- Participate in evaluation of the program.

Applicants will also be able to share their history with professional development, including their history with DEIA professional learning, and the geographic and socio-economic demographic of students and communities they reach through their instruction.
